In view of current COVID-19 pandemic which has most severely affected the normal functioning of schools
in the country, however, the school is pursuing to provide extension of affiliation so as to avoid any
difficulty for the purpose of admission /registration/ obtaining loan/renewal of various safety certificates
from appropriate state authorities.

Therefore, the competent authority of the Board after due consideration has accorded approval for extension
of Affiliation based on details/data submitted by school in online application for a further period of 5 years
subject to fulfilment of following conditions:

1. The school will follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt. from time to time.
2. The School is required to apply on online for further extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws, 2018.
3. The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned as mentioned in certificate as per appendix III, issued by District Education Officer (DEO) /equivalent officer
4. The school should ensure the strong governance and management of its activities in way of comprehensive and quantifiable planning in way of curriculum planning, infrastructure, resources, physical education, staff development and other co-curricular areas.
5. The school should go through the provision of Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and keep a copy there of for reference purpose and also advised to visit CBSE websites i.e. <http://cbseacademic.nic.in/> & <http://cbse.nic.in/> for updates. The School is expected to see all circulars on these CBSE websites regularly.
6. The school will strictly adhere to all rules regarding safety of students including Fire fighting and Transportation, etc. Further, school will provide adequate facilities for potable drinking water and clean healthy and hygienic toilets with washing facilities for boys and girls separately in proportion to the number of students. 10. The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of school name/logo/society/trust or any other identity related to running of school affiliated to CBSE. The school shall also be liable to bear all legal charges incurred by the Board, arising out of the circumstances.

- 13. The optimum Section teacher ratio of 1:1.5 as well as student teacher ratio of 30:1 is to be maintained to teach various subjects and school shall appoint qualified and trained teaching staff on regular basis as per provisions of Affiliation Bye Laws of the Board.
- 14. Every affiliated school shall sponsor regularly its bonafide and eligible students in Boards Class X and Class XII examinations from the year mentioned while granting affiliation/up-gradation regularly without break or inform with reasons thereof in writing well in time about the non-sponsoring of the candidates.
- 15. Running of coaching institutions in the school premises in the pretext of providing coaching to the students for various examinations is not permitted by the Board. Strict action would be taken on defaulters.
- 16. The Manger and the Principal of the school shall be jointly responsible for the authenticity of the online/offline documents/ information/data submitted by the School to the Board.
- 17. Apart from rules to be adhered to by the school as mentioned above for drawing specific attention of the school authorities, the school authorities are required to acquaint themselves with all the rules contained in Affiliation & Examination Bye-laws and circulars/guidelines/notification issued by the Board from time to time. Any laxity in following rules/instructions of the Board will lead to action against school as per clause 12 of Affiliation Bye-laws-2018.
- 18. The genuineness of information / documents / data submitted shall be of school and in case, if found otherwise the school shall invite action as per affiliation Bye laws-2018
- 19. The school shall be responsible for submission of any pending compliance, reply of show case /legal notice/ complaint and for submission of date/information sought by the Board. The extension of 05 years shall be from the date of cessation of previous validity of extension of affiliation
- 20. The school is required to remit pending fee, if any
- 21. The extension of affiliation is being granted as one time measure. However, the cases where the Show Cause Notice was communicated or grievance / legal cases are pending against the school, the Board will take appropriate decision in this matter

Extension in provisional recognition is granted to Guru Nanak Public School, Sector-36D, Chandigarh upto Senior Secondary level (Class XII) from 1.4.2019 to 31.3.2022 under Article 235 read with 241-A of Punjab Education Code subject to the condition that the school should ensure that all the conditions as given below are complied within six months before the expiry of the extended period of recognition failing which further recognition would not be considered:-

1. Provisions of RTE Act, Land Allotment obligatory clause and other instructions issued by the Education Department related to admission of students under EWS category and disadvantages groups be followed in letter and spirit (wherever applicable);
2. Reserve Fund be maintained in the name of DEO equal to 3 months salary of the teaching/non-teaching staff.
3. School will follow land allotment conditions and other notifications/orders/ instructions issued by the Chandigarh Administration from time to time;
4. Salary to the staff be paid as per Govt. Norms/CBSE Affiliation Bye Laws;
5. School will follow the provision of Rules of Recognition of Punjab Education Code;
6. No particular book shop be prescribed for purchase of book/uniform etc. by the school and instructions/guidelines issued by CBSE relating to books/uniforms are to be followed;
7. Fire Safety norms be followed meticulously and there should be no laxity in this regard on the part of school and complete Fire safety Certificate from the Fire Department, UT, Chandigarh be submitted to the office;
8. Ratio of Library books should be maintained;
9. Ratio of Computers should be maintained;
10. Fee should be charged from the students as per CBSE Affiliation Bye Laws and receipt be issued to the students against the money charged from them and provisions of The Punjab Regulation of Fee of un-aided Educational Institutions Act, 2016 as extended to the UT, Chandigarh & The Chandigarh, Union Territory Regulation of Fee of Un-aided Educational Institutions Rules, 2019 to be followed in letter and spirit;
11. Staff engaged should be fully qualified as per NCTE notifications issued from time to time and untrained teachers should be replaced with trained ones;
12. Recognition is liable to withdrawn if the Management or the staff of the school take part in agitation directed against the authority of Government, or disseminate opinions tending to excite feelings of disloyalty or disaffection against Government or of enmity and hatred between different classes or if the pupils are permitted to attend political meetings or to engage in any form of political or communal agitation;
13. Government reserves the right, to grant, refuse or withdraw recognition at its entire discretion;
14. The management will not add any more class/section to the school without the permission of the department;
15. The school will send a quarterly report regarding the progress made towards the fulfilment of various conditions mentioned above;
16. The school will not be transferred to different building or locality not already approved by the Department;

The recognition is also subject to the following conditions:-

- a) The School Management Committee may be got approved from the Education Department, Chandigarh Administration.
- b) The reserve fund must be completed equal to three months salary of the staff and pledged in the name of DEO, U.T., Chandigarh.
- c) Salary be paid to the Teachers and other staff strictly as per provision of Appendix-I of CBSE Affiliation by Laws.
- d) The school authority shall admit EWS students as per provisions of capital of Punjab (Dev. & Reg.) Act, 1952 and rules/instruction made their under notification dated 31.01.1996, 20.12.2001, 29.07.2005 and 27.09.2016 be followed in letter and spirit.
- e) The Contract of service between management and staff must be followed.
- f) Some of the teachers are not fulfilling the basic qualification as per NCTE norms. Such teachers need to acquire minimum qualification or replacing them with qualified teachers.

History of land allotment to Guru Nanak Public School, Sector 36-D, Chandigarh

Initially, Guru Nanak Public School Association (Regd) was allotted land measuring 72999.513 sq. yds in Sector 36D by the Chandigarh Administration vide letter No.11741/RCE-99(G-III), dated 23.10.1970. However, at the time of taking its possession, it was found that a Choe is flowing through the area. Existence of the Choe left a considerable area as unfit to be used by the school. On the request of the management of the School, the Chandigarh Administration decided that the school may be compensated by allotting additional area in Sector 37B. Finally, an area comprising of 52375.987 sq. yds was allotted in Sector 36D (Site No.I measuring 36141.059 sq. yds in front of houses Nos.1564-1565 and Site No.II measuring 16234.928 sq. yds. adjacent to the Dalhia Garden) vide Estate Office, Chandigarh letter No.7125/RCE-199/G-III, dated 1.7.1974. The possession of the plot was given on 26.7.1974. Another plot comprising of 21046.23 sq.yds was allotted in Sector 37B vide Estate Office Chandigarh letter No.11465/RCE-199/G-III, dated 22.8.77. The possession of the plot was given on 7.10.77.

Finally, the conveyance deeds of the two plots (52375.987 sq. yds in Sector 36D and 21046.23 sq. yds in Sector 37B) have been got registered in favour of the Guru Nanak Public School, Chandigarh vide Sr. No.4062, Book No.1, Volume 164, dated 12.12.07 and Sr.No.4063, Book No.1, Volume 164 dated 12.12.07 respectively.
